

PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE CHANGES FROM SATURDAY 28TH AUGUST 2021

Changes will be made to some bus services in South Yorkshire from the weekend of Saturday, 28th August which will include the following:

- A temporary reduction in frequency to services 15/15a, 66 and 81/82 in Doncaster from every 10 minutes to every 15 minutes, and service 55/56 from every 15 minutes to 20 minutes, to help national staff shortages affecting the region.
- Timetable changes to improve punctuality and reinstate some journeys as per pre-Covid operations, some journeys will provide school trips rather than local bus journeys:
- A temporary retention of summer timetable for services 1, 7/8/8a, 24/25, 83/83a, 88,52/52a and 120 in Sheffield to help manage a national issue of staff shortages affecting the region.
